Social Distancing

At **ALL** times:-

- Parents, carers **AND** children **MUST** practise social distancing, keeping a **2 meter** distance, from themselves and others not in their household.
- Social distancing **MUST** be used on the journey to and from school
- Social distancing **MUST** be adhered to on the school site.

Start of the school day and end of the school day.

Parents/carers **MUST** follow the protocols for movement around the school site, instructions on where to stand and the instructions for delivering their child and collecting their child to and from school.

Parents **MUST** ensure their child follows these protocols too.

Parents **MUST** follow the instructions for school start and finish times.

Packed Lunches

Parents must provide their child with a packed lunch to eat at lunch times and a mid-morning snack. They should provide their child with a named water bottle every day.

The lunch and snack should follow the school's 'no nut' guidance. Food provided must not contain nuts or trace of nuts.

There will be no facilities available to wash fruit, heat up food, or wash spoons or cutlery.

Children in receipt of free School Meals will be provided with a free packed lunch.

Child or other household members displaying Covid-19 symptoms

Parents must be aware of and must follow government/ NHS protocols around the monitoring of their health and the health of their children and their family.

If symptoms become apparent then parents must inform school in a timely manner and co-operate positively with the school if the school asks for a child to remain at home or be collected from school as a result of a risk assessment.

Parents **SHOULD** take their children to be tested, if showing symptoms.

The School reserves the right to refuse a child in school, if these procedures are not followed to ensure the safety of the wider school community.
