Risk Assessments for vulnerable pupils.

Risk assessments will be put into place for those pupils who are considered vulnerable pupils, for example:-

- those pupils who are unlikely to cope with social distancing
- those who are unlikely to cope with the changes to the classroom set up,
- those unlikely to cope with the changes in approach to learning
- those who with a positive handling plan

Risk assessments for those pupils who are considered 'extremely clinically vulnerable' or live with someone who is considered 'extremely clinically vulnerable'.

Risk assessments for those pupils who are considered 'clinically vulnerable' or live with someone who is considered 'clinically vulnerable'.

If the risk assessment considers the need for PPE when working with these children this will be issued to the agreed adults

If the risk assessment considers that the child is unsafe in school, the child will continue learning from home rather than in school attendance; parents will be informed of the decision in a compassionate manner. A plan will be put in place to ensure face to face electronic engagement is available for the pupil on a regular basis.
