Academy Approach to Remote Learning

Greenway Academy's philosophy is that ALL children are vulnerable as a result of COVID-19 pandemic, and should be in school face-to-face learning, where at all possible. This is the statutory expectation from Monday 8th March 2021.

Children will only be absent from school if they are:-

- Medically unfit to be in school
- Self-isolating due to COVID-19 positive test
- Self-isolating awaiting test result
- Directed to as a result of a full local/national lockdown

The Remote Learning Offer is available through the school website, for children absent from school. A weekly timetable is published in the prior week, providing pre-recorded lessons, linked printable activities as well as independent learning activities. The timetable will match the in-school curriculum offer, as much as possible.

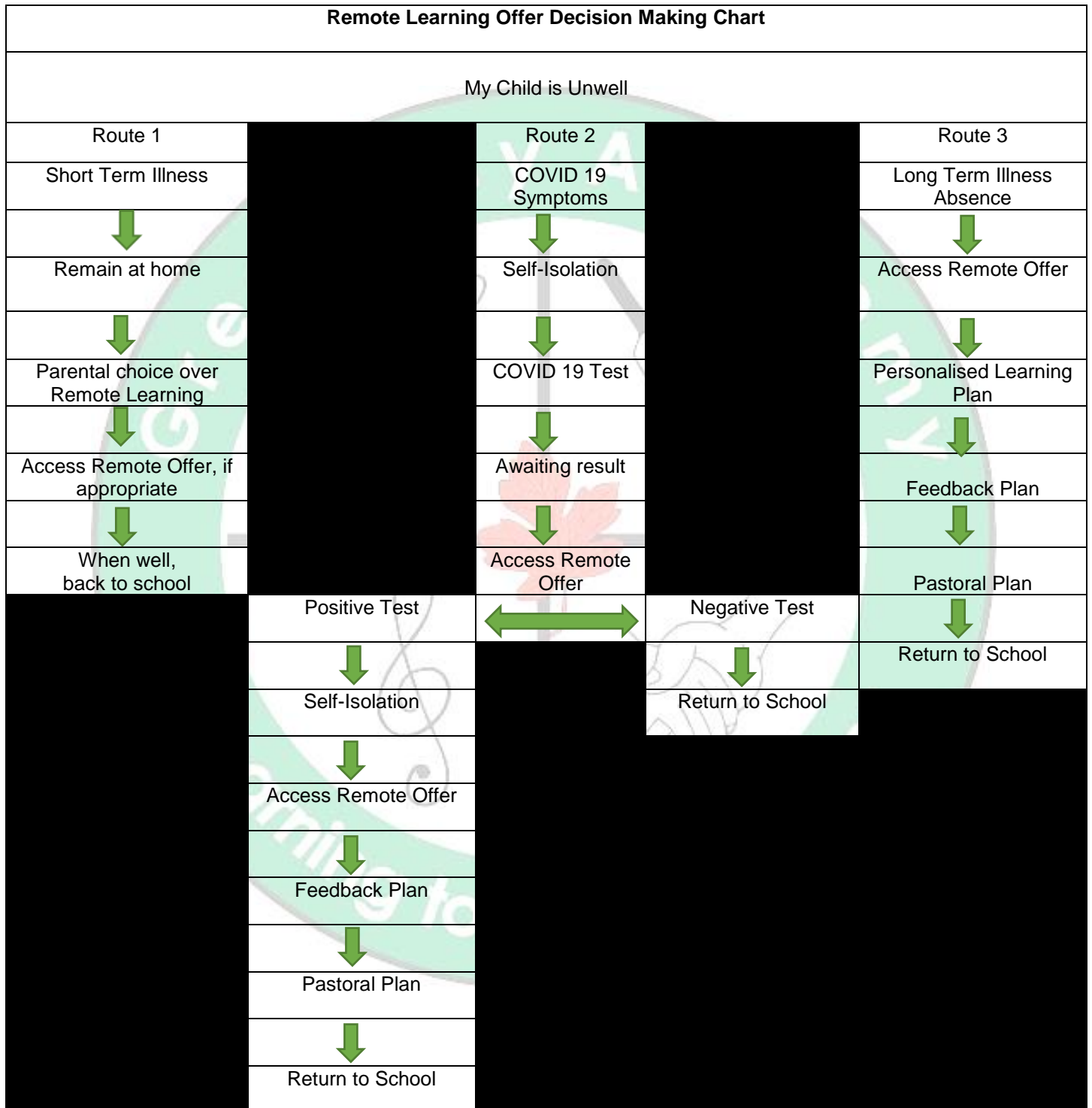
The Remote Learning Offer will be adapted for pupils depending on the time absent to provide academic learning, teacher input/feedback and pastoral support.

Where a child is absent for a substantial period of time, a return to school plan will be agreed with parents and the pupil.

The Remote Learning Offer is a positive outcome of the pandemic, providing a forward-looking solution for those children who are required to self-isolate and for those pupils who have medical conditions, which may require periods of home learning.

If a pupil is absent for more than 2 days (average test return time), contact will be made with parents to arrange the following:-

- Feedback Plan, covering teacher learning support and feedback/celebration on learning returned/uploaded
- Pastoral Plan, covering social links with pastoral team and peers

Where a pupil is absent for a significant period, a Return to School Plan will also be agreed to ensure a smooth transition back into school.

Short-term absence resources will be printable, or can be requested and collected as a pack from school.

Attendance

Continue to inform the school of any absence and the reasons why, using the current published procedures, noting that all COVID related absences, are recorded with a special code which does not count towards overall attendance for the school or the pupil.

Remote Learning Personalised Plan

This plan will be agreed for any child with a positive COVID result, or family member where full isolation has to be completed or is absent from school for more than 5 learning days as a result of a medical condition (including surgery).
